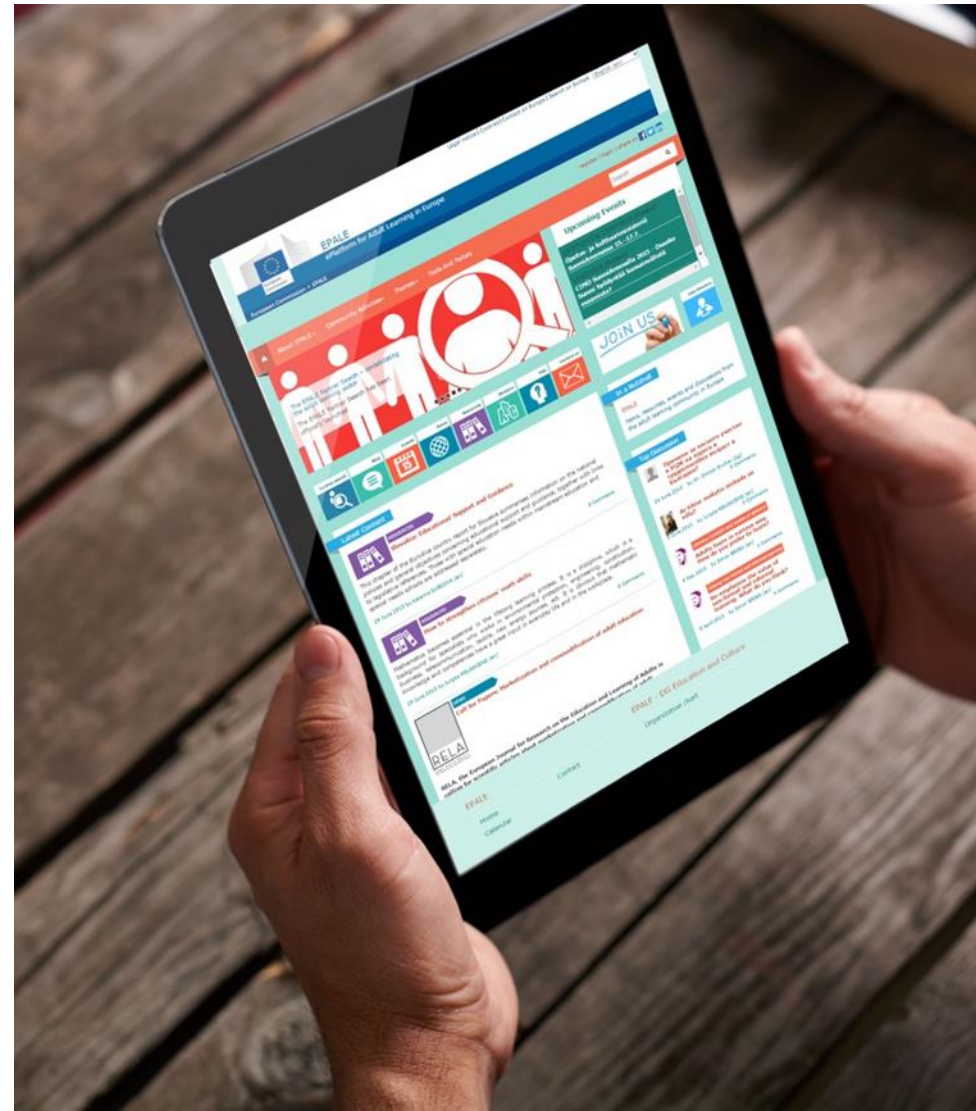


What is EPALE?
